Dear Parent / Guardian,

There have been a number of cases of flu in the College over the last two weeks. One pupil has been confirmed on the evening of 5<sup>th</sup> February as having swine flu. The boys concerned have been isolated from the rest of the school and all appropriate measures have been put in place to minimise further spread. The boys are recovering well without any complications.

The incidence of swine flu has been declining in recent weeks but is still present in the community. We have taken advice from the Public Health Agency and the school doctor and I am required to remind parents that pupils with flu like symptoms should not come to school but stay at home until fully recovered. This is an important directive and a necessary measure to prevent spread of infection within the College. If a pupil does develop suspicious symptoms and you need advice, then you should contact your GP.
